Presentation Theme

- ❖ Use of technology and electronic medical records to impact vaccination tracking and analysis

Set-Up/Break-Down

FOCUS

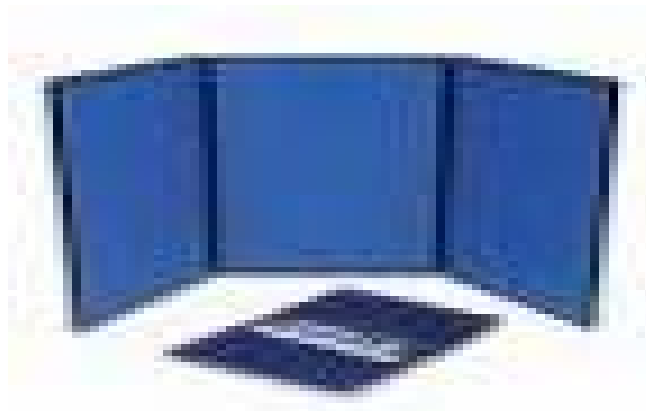
